

1. Fielding Methodology. Change 4 to the Improved Load Bearing Equipment Capabilities Development Document calls for the fielding of a new material solution to accommodate the service common pistol. The currently fielded M-12 Holster does not provide the warfighter with the modularity required to rapidly deploy their weapon. This has resulted in the need for a holster that can be transitioned from the drop leg position, waist position, or mounted to the PALS located on all Marine Corps fielded body armor systems. The United States Marine Corps (USMC) Holster will address these requirements.

The Approved Acquisition Objective (AAO) established by Deputy Commandant, Combat Development & Integration (DC, CD&I) in the Total Force Structure Management System is currently 27,455 USMC Holsters, which correlates with the AAO for the M9 Semiautomatic Pistol. The 27,455 USMC Holsters and associated logistics maintenance support quantities will be distributed to gaining commands through the Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF) controlled Equipment Receipt and Distribution Teams (ERDT). The ERDTs will be responsible for coordinating distributions of the USMC Holster down to the unit level. The USMC Holster Repair Kits will also be provided to gaining commands by a ratio of one repair kit per ten USMC Holsters in order to support the fielded AAO quantities. These repair kits will be maintained by unit level armories.

The USMC Holster will be distributed to the MEFs' gaining commands through the ERDTs. USMC Holsters going to Marine Forces Reserve (MFR) will be shipped directly to the gaining commands. Training & Education Command (TECOM), Base, Post, and Station quantities will also be shipped directly to the gaining commands. To minimize shipping costs, in some cases TECOM units may be supported by ERDTs.

a. Physical Characteristics. The USMC Holster program will replace the single unit of the M-12 Pistol Holster with an integrated system using a modular holster. The USMC Holster system will be delivered pre-assembled in four major components, to include: one composite and/or polymer holster with male connector attached, one waist belt platform with female quick disconnect attached, one drop-leg platform with female quick disconnect attached, and one PALS platform with female quick disconnect attached. All components within the USMC Holster system are ambidextrous, except the leg platform. As such, the USMC Holster system will be available in right and left handed configurations. The length, height, and width are displayed in inches. The weight is displayed in pounds:

4. Support Costs. During the base contract year, Marine Corps Systems Command (MARCORSYSCOM) purchased the USMC Holster Repair Kits at a ratio of one repair kit per ten USMC Holsters in order to support the fielded AAO quantities for 24 months. The USMC Holster repair kits will be maintained by unit level armories. Additionally, warranty information is provided in each Holster Kit. A minimum quantity of initial issue spares will be managed by the PM ICE Life Cycle Logistician and maintained at Marine Corps Logistics Base (MCLB) Barstow, California.

5. Fielding Support. Standard material handling equipment may be required at the receiving facility in order to off load pallets and/or boxes from delivery trucks.

6. Maintenance Support. Maintenance of the USMC Holster will be conducted at the operator level. High unserviceability rates of the USMC Holster are not anticipated. Maintenance of USMC Holsters will be accomplished by unit armorers using the fielded USMC Holster repair kits. Should a buckle become broken or inoperable, the armorer will replace them with the repair buckles issued in the Repair Kit. If a USMC Holster is damaged during use and the user determines it is unable to safely retain the M9 pistol, the user should turn it in to their armory. The armory will turn the unserviceable systems into their organic supply for disposal and replacement.

7. Designated Support Depots. The USMC Holster does not require depot level maintenance.

8. Calibration Requirements. There are no calibration requirements for the USMC Holster.

9. Contractor Support Requirement. There are no additional contractor logistics support requirements for this item. Standard MEF ERDTs and current Marine Corps Table of Organization are sufficient and will be utilized for care in storage.

10. Manpower/Personnel. No additional manpower is required to field the USMC Holster as it is a one for one replacement of the M-12 Holster. No new Military Occupational Specialty will be required as a result of fielding the USMC Holster.

11. Training. Training by the ICE Training Team can be scheduled through the PM ICE Website at: <http://www.marcorsyscom.usmc.mil/sites/pmice/nett.asp> or by sending a request to pmice@usmc.mil. Contact information for MARCORSYSCOM FSRs is provided below in Table 6. End users are encouraged to call FSR's to address any questions concerning the USMC Holster.

12. Training and Performance Support Items. One Instruction Card will be included with each USMC Holster. This card will provide a basic overview of the USMC Holster and its components. Paragraph 11 above and the fielding message will encourage units to contact their local FSR to schedule on site training at each delivery location. Training will include instruction on assembly, fit, and function of the USMC Holster. Additional training is being developed at Weapons Training Battalion and will be included in the combat pistol course. Marines firing the service pistol during the combat pistol course will receive training on the proper use of the pistol with the USMC Holster System.

13. Supply Support. A minimum quantity of initial issue spares were procured on the contract and will be stored at MCLB Barstow, California. MARCORSYSCOM, PM ICE will manage the distribution of these initial issue spares. Additionally, MARCORSYSCOM will provide one (1) USMC Holster Repair Kit for every ten (10) USMC Holster kits to all gaining command to support replacement of missing or broken components. These repair kits will be maintained by unit level armories. Gaining Commands will contact the Life Cycle Logistician, listed in Table 2 above, when questions regarding the USMC Holster Repair Kits or Components arise. The USMC Holster Repair Kit manufacturer information is as follows:

MARCORSYSCOM is providing the USMC Holster Repair Kit as sustainment for the Holster through Fiscal Year (FY) 2013. During the two years of initial sustainment provided by MARCORSYSCOM, the Life Cycle Logistician will submit Supply Request Packages to transition sustainment to Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Troop Support beginning in FY14. When this transition occurs, end users using organizational funds will procure required components of the USMC Holster Repair Kit through the DLA Troop Support.

14. Support Equipment. There is no support equipment for the USMC Holster.

15. Technical Publications. Technical publications (TP) supporting the fielding of the USMC Holster include the Instruction Card and the USMC Holster Training Sheet. Gaining Commands will ensure that one Instruction Card is provided with each USMC Holster issued.

16. Computer Resources Support. There is no computer resource support requirement for the USMC Holster.

17. Facilities. The USMC Holster is a one for one replacement of the currently fielded M-12 holster. As the system is modular, it is not expected to take up additional space above and beyond what is already used by the M-12 holster. Once fielded, the USMC Holster will be ultimately be maintained at the user level. As required, PM ICE will submit a Facilities Impact Report (FIR) to the Facilities Planning Officer at Head Quarters Marine Corps, Installations & Logistics. The FIR will be included as an appendix once approved.

18. Packaging, Handling, Storage, and Transportation

a. Packaging. Packaging of the USMC Holster and associated components shall be accomplished in accordance with the current version of Military Standard (MIL STD) 130, ensuring the items reach their final destination in their original condition. All shipments will be on 40 X 48 inch four way pallet (standard military pallet). All shipping containers shall be marked with durable, legible print that includes quantities, lot numbers, weight, cube

dimensions, the contract number, delivery order number, and the Contractor's name and address. All marking will be in accordance with current versions of MIL STD 129 and MIL STD 130.

b. Handling. Upon delivery from manufacturer, receiving entities may require material handling equipment for off load.

c. Storage. All Equipment will be stored at gaining commands in accordance with industry best practices.

d. Transportation. The USMC Holster will be maintained by the end user. It is safe to transport using any military and/or commercial resource available.

19. Warranties. The manufacturer warrants that the USMC Holsters are free from failures due to manufacturing defects, to include but not limited to workmanship, materials, or design failures, for 12 months upon final delivery by manufacturer and after inspection/acceptance by the Government. See warranty card included in each system.

20. Materiel Defects Reporting.

a. Submit all form, fit and function defects and product quality deficiencies in accordance with Marine Corps Order (MCO) 4855.10, using the Product Quality Deficiency Reports (PQDR) Form, Standard Form (SF) 368. Electronic submission will be to the PQDR Screening Point website at www.logcom.usmc.mil/pqdr, in accordance with Technical Manual 4700-15/1 and MCO 4855.10.

b. Submit Supply Discrepancy Reports (SDR), on SF 364, per Users Manual (UM) 4400-124, and Secretary of the Navy Instruction 4355.18, "Reporting of the Item and Packaging Discrepancies" on shortages, overages, packaging, and preservation discrepancies. Any damage due to improper packaging will be submitted via SDR procedures.

c. Damage due to shipping discrepancies will be submitted using a Transportation Discrepancy Report, (SF361) in accordance with Defense Logistics Agency Regulation 4500.15/ Army Regulation 55-38/ Naval Supply Instruction 4610.33/ Air Force Regulation 75-18/MCO P4610.19 and in accordance with UM 4400-124 and MCO P4610.16 "Uniform Settlement of Military Freight Loss and Damage Claims."

21. Security Requirements/Controlled Item. The USMC Holster is not classified as a controlled item. System security requirements and procedures are not applicable.

22. Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health. There are no identified environmental or health issues associated with the USMC Holster.

23. Coordination Between System Being Fielded and System Being Replaced.

a. The USMC Holster is replacing the currently fielded M-12 Holster (National Stock Number 1095-01-194-5545, Part Number 9388057).

b. Once gaining commands have received their total AAO they are authorized to dispose of the M-12 Holster using their local Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office.

24. Fielding Responsibilities. Distribution of the USMC Holster will be handled through the MEF ERDTs or shipped directly to gaining commands. Appendix B contains the AAO for the USMC Holster. Appendix C contains the Fielding Schedule broken down by ship-to location.

a. **Gaining Commands.** Gaining Commands have no direct fielding responsibility.

b. **MARCORSYSCOM.** MARCORSYSCOM will complete the following actions:

(1) Notify DC, CD&I when the Fielding Plan is signed by the Milestone Delegation Authority so that allowance data coincides with the project in-service date.

(2) The USMC Holster Fielding Team consists of the personnel listed in Table 8 below.

(3) Publish Intent to Field Message.

c. Marine Corps Logistics Command (MARCORLOGCOM).

(1) MARCORLOGCOM PQDR Section will assist the PM ICE Equipment Specialist with PQDR Trend Analysis and report the results to PM ICE Lead Logistics Management Specialist.

(2) Load Fielding Plan to technical publication website.

d. DLA Troop Support. DLA Troop Support will assist the PM ICE Equipment Specialist in the attainment of NSNs in the fielding and sustainment of equipment.

25. Actions Required to Place Equipment in Service

a. Gaining Commands.

(1) Conduct a serviceability inspection of each USMC Holster when received to ensure there are no defects in quality or workmanship. Discrepancies noted will be reported to the Life Cycle Logistician or Team Leader (Table 2) for resolution via MARCORLOGCOM.

(2) Upon receipt of items, ensure a signed, legible copy of the receipt documentation, DD 250 or DD 1348-1, is submitted to the MARCORSYSCOM Project Officer listed in Table 1.

(2) In accordance with MCO P4400-150 load the USMC Holster to unit property records.

b. MARCORLOGCOM

(1) Maintain and ensure the availability of any TP related to the equipment.

(2) Assist in the life cycle support aspect of the program.

(3) Ensure that one Instruction Card is provided with each issued USMC Holster issued.

c. MARCORSYSCOM

(1) Equipment Specialist will assist and support in the cataloging and assignment of NSNs.

26. Post Fielding Support. MARCORSYSCOM PM ICE is responsible for Total Life Cycle Management of the system per Department of Defense Directive 5000.1.

a. Life Cycle Support. The Life Cycle Management Team consists of the Project Officer, Life Cycle Logistician, and Equipment Specialist listed in Table 2. Any post fielding support issues should be addressed with members of this team.

b. Supply Support. The MARCORSYSCOM, PM ICE, USMC Holster Life Cycle Logistician will manage spares located in MCLB, Barstow, CA.

c. Software Support. There is no software support required for the USMC Holster.

d. Configuration Management and Engineering Changes. Any changes to the configuration of the USMC Holster will be submitted via Engineering Change Proposals (ECPs) to the USMC Holster Project Officer listed in Table 2. Marine Corps entities who wish to initiate an ECP may contact the Systems Engineer from Table 2 for additional information. Approval of ECPs will be the responsibility of the Configuration Control Board.

e. Training Support. Individual units are authorized to make duplicate copies of the Instruction Card included in the USMC Holster system as required/requested.

f. DLA Troop Support. MARCORSYSCOM will transition sustainment to DLA Troop Support beginning in FY14. When this transition occurs, end users, using organizational funds, will procure required components of the USMC Holster Repair Kit, through the DLA Troop Support.
