**Administrative Instructions:** The following instructions are provided to ease the transition and aid travelers in their preparation. If questions or concerns arise, do not hesitate to contact the Academics Section

- ❖ Students must have fully funded orders approved by TECOM through DTS.
- ❖ Students must bring their, Medical and Dental Records, and a copy of their Original Orders.
- ❖ Government quarters (barracks) are not available, messing at the 21 Area is available.
- ❖ Students need a valid Military ID with updated PKI Cert and Pin Number. They will need to have an active military e-mail account so they can access their DTS orders online. AAS S-1 has no viewing access/rights to the Marine’s DTS account because the students are in TAD status, only the parent command or initiator of the DTS orders can view or make changes. The e-mail account will ensure that the Marine can log into our computers and access their DTS accounts. By doing this, we can help pinpoint any issues and help resolve any problems. This is required because we constantly have funding issues, where your Marines do not get their scheduled pay advances, which puts them in severe financial hardship. Provide your Marines with Government Travel Charge Cards to alleviate any unexpected funding problems.
- ❖ Upon arrival at the airport the Marine will check out a rental vehicle or take a shuttle from the airport to Camp Pendleton. Ensure that all receipts are saved.
- ❖ The command should attempt to make billeting reservations at transient quarters for the duration of the course, to coincide with flight arrival and departure dates.
- ❖ Reservation information:

  - Marine Manor (Main side) (760) 430-4702 or DSN 365-3718
- ❖ If the Marine ends up staying on Main side or off-base, they will need funding for a rental vehicle funded by parent command, not TECOM). If more than one Marine from the same unit will be attending, only the senior Marine will need a vehicle.
- ❖ AAS cannot pay any; Per Diem, lodging, transportation advances, or partial liquidation for Marines assigned TEMINS or TAD.
- ❖ All Marines must have a Government Travel Charge Card. The card needs to be activated and have a minimum of a \$5000 limit.
- ❖ The students receive two kinds of Per-Diem funding. Billeting Per-Diem and Messing Per-Diem. Our command DOES NOT authorize full Messing Per-Diem because according to Joint Travel Regulations, messing is available in 21 Area. All of our training is done in 21 Area and our training schedule allows them to use the messing facility. Even if your Marines are staying in off-base billeting, they DO NOT rate the full messing Per-Diem. All they rate is \$12.90 per day.
- ❖ If Marines checking in during times of promotion boards, ensure all of their matters pertaining to board materials are completed prior to attending course. (Photos etc.)
- ❖ The parent command must complete a TD fitness report.

### **Packing list for AAVRI**

1. Service "A" Uniform
2. Seasonal MCCUU (sleeves up or down depending on the season)
3. Seasonal Service uniform (service "B" or service "C")
4. Clean and serviceable coveralls (no holes, rips, tears. Must be free from POLs). Coveralls will be cuffed (bloused) while wearing them. Sleeves will be rolled up or down depending on the scenario (no "half rolls"). Coveralls will NEVER be worn "half-mast".
5. Steel toed Marine Corps boots (aka safety boots)
6. Appropriate civilian attire
7. Green on green PT gear
8. Civilian PT gear
