A COPY OF THE FORM WILL BE SENT TO THE CMC (MMEA) PRIOR TO THE MARINE DETACHING STIPULATING SUCCESSFUL OR UNSUCCESSFUL SCREENING BY THE COMMANDING OFFICER.

- 1. $\underline{\text{Background}}$. Instructor duty is primarily defined as duty with a formal school. Permanent change of station orders directing the transfer of Marines to other isolated assignments require screening for instructor duty in accordance with this order when directed by the Commandant of the Marine Corps.
- 2. Action. One copy of the completed Commanding Officer's Screening/Interview Guide will be hand carried by Marine to gaining Command. The results of the completed screening will be reported to the gaining command and info HQMC MMEA-82(353X Monitor). Thirty days prior to transfer, the commanding officer will recertify that the Marine is still qualified for instructor duty. The command will contact the HQMC MMEA 82 (353X Monitor) via naval message when there is a change in the Marine's status. The gaining command should make every effort to contact the losing command to ensure the inbound Marine remains qualified. Upon request, certain criteria may be waived by the HQMC MMEA-82 (353X Monitor).
