



COMMANDING OFFICER'S PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES AND CONDUCT POLICY STATEMENT




Marine Corps Order 5354.1G establishes policy and defines specific prohibited activities and conduct. The order includes, but is not limited to, acts or participation in hazing, bullying, ostracism, harassment in any form, wrongful distribution or broadcasting of intimate images, and dissident or protest activities, including supremacist activity. All personnel aboard Field Medical Training Battalion – West (FMTB-W) will be treated with the utmost respect, dignity, and courtesy. Discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or national origin is in stark contradiction to our core values and will not be tolerated.

Our command climate will be free from discrimination, sexual harassment, or hazing in any form. These behaviors violate our Core Values of Honor, Courage, and Commitment and undermine the dignity, respect, and trust that is critical to our success. As such, prohibited activities and conduct will not be tolerated and will be immediately addressed. I expect all members of this command to take charge of their areas and ensure the atmosphere in which they operate is positive, supportive, and harassment-free for all.

I have ZERO tolerance of any Marine, Sailor, or civilian that fails to report instances of discrimination, hazing, and/or harassment of any kind and they will be held accountable.

FMTB-West must strive to resolve allegations or perceptions of discrimination, hazing, or sexual harassment complaints at the lowest level using the Informal Resolution System. When this is not possible, formal complaints will be submitted to our Command Equal Opportunity Representative, the Training Command Equal Opportunity Advisor, or the Inspector General of the United States Marine Corps. Reprisals, intimidation, or harassment related to the reporting of the complaint will not be tolerated and will be dealt with accordingly.
