Every victim of sexual assault has Reporting Options:

Unrestricted Reporting

Offers the most services and safety measures

A victim can report their assault and receive:

- Medical treatment and counseling
- Support from the Command
- And official law enforcement investigation to hold the offender accountable
 - Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC)
 - Uniformed or Civilian Victim Advocate
 - Marine & Family Programs Counselor

Restricted Reporting*

Offers more time to make decisions about reporting

A victim can confidentially report and receive:

- Support and counseling
- NO command involvement
- NO law enforcement involvement

To receive a Restricted Report **ONLY** report to the:

- Chaplain
- Medical Personnel (with your UVA)
- Military Attorney

You may contact any UVA 24/7 if you need assistance.

RESTRICTED REPORTING

Allows a Marine who is sexually assaulted to **confidentially** report the assault and receive support, medical treatment, and counseling

without a law enforcement investigation or chain of command involvement.

For **RESTRICTED** reporting, you must only report to one of these individuals:

- SARC** (Sexual Assault Response Coordinator)
- UVA** (Uniformed Victim Advocate)
- Chaplain**

UNRESTRICTED REPORTING

Allows a Marine who is sexually assaulted to report the assault and receive support, medical treatment, and counseling

with a law enforcement investigation and support from the chain of command

For **UNRESTRICTED** reporting, can report to any one of these individuals:

- SARC** (Sexual Assault Response Coordinator)
- UVA** (Uniformed Victim Advocate)
- Chain of Command**
