

ADVANCED ELECTRICIAN COURSE INFORMATION:

PREREQUISITES: Corporal through Staff Sergeant with one year experience in MOS 1141. All students must have certification of current sustainment for T&R events 1100-SAFE-1001 (Conduct Risk Management) and 1100-SAFE-1002 (Control Hazardous Energy).

Waiver for Lance Corporal to Staff Sergeant with any OccFld 1100 MOS: Must have at least one year experience, a minimum of one year remaining in current enlistment, and a waiver approved by Director of Instruction, MCES.

PURPOSE: To provide designated advanced level training to Electricians (MOS 1141) in compliance with the training continuum required by the Operating Forces.

SCOPE: This course is designed to impart the advanced knowledge and skills required to supervise an electrical section and plan/provide electrical support. The course consists of instruction in the planning and supervision of electric power generation and distribution in the field environment; and the assessment, design, installation, and inspection of interior electrical wiring systems of structures, while complying with applicable codes. Conducting Values Based Leadership (VBL) training is also covered.
