## PURPOSE

The purpose of Security Cooperation Planners Course is to provide Joint Force, Interagency, Theater Security Cooperation Officers, MEF and subordinate (SC) planners, MARFOR Security Cooperation (SC) Planners, Regional Planners, Foreign Area Officers (FAO), Regional Affairs Officers (RAO), Foreign Area Staff Non-commissioned Officers (FAS), and Regional Affairs Staff Non-commissioned Officers (RAS) with the ability to analyze national, regional, interagency, joint, maritime, and Marine Corps policy and guidance to identify common objectives and apply planning considerations to the development and execution of engagement plans that achieve US stated objectives and end states.

## SCOPE

This five-day course will explore the policies, procedures, and methods used to develop and execute SC engagement plans. Students will gain an understanding of SC policy, doctrine, and guidance documents as well as engagement planning best practices, funding authorities, and foreign disclosure. The course will also address the relationship between the Department of Defense and the Department of State, as it relates to SC. The course is built around lectures, panel discussions, and a series of practical exercises which guide students' creation of key parts of a Security Cooperation Engagement Plan (SCEP).

## PREREQUISITES

Students are required to complete the following online modules, which are available via DSCU/DAU. All modules must be complete in order to receive formal SCPC certification credit:

### Required

- SC-101 - INTRO TO SECURITY COOPERATION
- SOC-101 - INTRO TO SOCIUM

The following are recommended for the course and are required by SCWD Order as Basic-Level Certification per TITLE 10 U.S.C. SECTION 384, DODI 5132.15, and MCO 5710.6D.

- SC-001 - SECURITY COOPERATION FAMILIARIZATION
- SC-111 - INTRODUCTION TO TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER
- SC-121 - INTRODUCTION TO END USE MONITORING
- SC-151 - INTRODUCTION TO CROSS CULTURAL COMPETENCE AND REGIONAL ORIENTATION

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Prospective students will request enrollment through their chain of command. Once approved, students will receive a confirmation email explaining DSCU registration for SC-101, and containing the course reporting instructions. For any additional information or assistance with enrollment, please contact the SCPC Director or SCPC Course Chief. Required rank for attending this course is O3-O6, WO 01-CWO4 and E6-E9. A security clearance level of Secret is required for all attendees.
