SUBJ/SOLICITATION OF NOMINEES FOR THE FY22 COMBAT MARKSMANSHIP COACH RESERVE (CMCR) COURSE (CID: M02R3C9)

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GENTEXT/RMKS/1. Situation. The USMCR Formal Marksmanship Training Unit (FMTU) will conduct the FY22 Combat Marksmanship Coach Reserve (CMCR) course, 17 September 2022 through 2 October 2022 at Camp Upshur, MCB Quantico, VA. Implementation continues for the New Annual Rifle Qualification (ARQ) with RC units required to execute ARQ only in FY23. The CMCR Course trains Coaches in the execution of this new course of fire.

2. Mission. From 17 September 2022 through 2 October 2022, the USMCR FMTU will qualify COMMARFORRES Marines as Combat Marksmanship Coaches (CMC), MOS 0933, to facilitate planning, coordination, and execution of unit level marksmanship instruction and requalification.

3. Execution.

3.A. Commander's intent. Not Applicable.

3.B. Concept of Operations. This course of instruction is designed for qualified Marines who have the potential to be CMC's at the unit level. Students will receive instruction and annual service rifle/pistol qualification. The course convenes at 0600 on 18 September 2022 aboard Camp Upshur, MCB Quantico,

VA and continues thru 1200, 2 October 2022. Class capacity is 140 students. Students must report NLT 1800 on 17 September 2022.

3.C. Tasks. NLT 12 August 2022, MSC G-3 training departments will consolidate nominations and enter them in the Marine Corps Training Information Management System (MCTIMS). Unfilled MSC allocations will be redistributed by COMMARFORRES G-3/5, Training and Readiness Branch. Total allocations are 140. Quota distribution is as follows:

3.C.1. FHG - 25 seats.

3.C.2. 4TH MARDIV - 50 seats.

3.C.3. 4TH MLG - 40 seats.

3.C.4. 4TH MAW - 25 seats.

3.D. Coordinating Instructions.

3.D.1. Prerequisites.

3.D.1.A. LCpl thru GySgt, any Military Occupational Specialty (MOS).

3.D.1.B. Current Sharpshooter or higher qualification with the Service rifle.

3.D.1.C. SMCR obligors must have two years of SMCR obligated service remaining on contract upon completion of this course or sign a Standard Written Agreement to Train (SWAT) to remain in a SMCR unit for two years upon completion.

3.D.1.D. Full duty status and have 20/20 corrected vision.

3.D.1.E. Must meet Marine Corps height and weight standards.

3.D.1.F. This message is the course pre-screening checklist. Units must ensure that attendees check-in with a complete copy of this message and a copy of their Basic Individual Record (BIR) and Basic Training Record (BTR). All attendees must meet the course pre-requisites and report with all gear list items. COVID ROM requirements are already reflected in dates; facemasks are required.

3.D.1.G. Attendees that report in non-compliance with the course prerequisites will be returned to their parent command. Prerequisite waivers will not be accepted or approved.

3.D.2. Selection Criteria. Priority of CMCR seat assignment will be SMCR, Active Reserve, and Active Component Marines assigned to COMMARFORRES commands.

4. Administration and Logistics.

4.A. Funding. Pay and allowances for SMCR Marines will be funded utilizing MROWS; Order Type: Schools; Sub Type: Refresher Proficiency Training; PID RPT with Budget Execution Activity/Budget Execution Sub- Activity (BEA/BESA) G3/MR.

4.B. Travel. Travel days are 17 September 2022 and 2 October 2022.

4.B.1. SMCR Marines issued MROWS orders utilizing DTS as the travel system will use the "22 RPT ENL A4" Line of Accounting and "QUAN G3 SCHOOLS" as the routing list for authorizations.

4.B.2. In order to minimize ground transportation costs to/from MCB Quantico, arrival/departure airport for Marines traveling by commercial air is Washington Reagan National Airport (DCA).

4.B.3. Units will ensure all flights are scheduled to arrive between 0900 and 1600 Eastern Standard Time (EST) on the report date (17 September 2022). Once Marines arrive at DCA, they will be met by a Marine liaison at the United Services Organization (USO) for transportation to MCB, Quantico. The USO is located on the Concourse Level, Terminal A, across from "Lost and Found" office.

4.B.4. Departure flights must be scheduled to depart no earlier than 1400 on 2 October 2022.

4.B.5. In accordance with Defense Table of Official Distances and if PMA/PLEAD is less than a 400-mile one way drive to MCB Quantico, POV's are encouraged as deemed cost advantageous to the government. However, in-and-around mileage will not be authorized.

4.B.6. Physical address to check-in: 26102 Bailey Avenue, Camp Upshur, MCB Quantico, VA, 22134. Driving directions to Camp Upshur from locations north or south:

- Take I-95 North or South to Exit 148.
- I-95N turn left, I-95S turn right, onto Russell Road and proceed 2 miles to and through the Ponderosa Gate.
- You are now on MCB Quantico and traveling on MCB-4, continue for approximately 3.5 miles until you reach MCB-1 on the right.
- Turn right onto MCB-1 and follow to MCB-8; you will come to a stop sign (t-intersection, approx. 10 miles).
- Turn left at the stop sign onto MCB-8 and follow to Bailey Street (look for Camp Upshur sign on the right, approximately .25 mile).
- Turn right onto Bailey Street and follow to Bldg 26102 (first building on your right, approximately 1.5 miles).

4.C. Government billeting and messing is available. Billeting will be provided at Camp Upshur (open squad bay). This is the only authorized billeting for the CMCR course. No billeting or check-in support will be available until 1000 on the report date, 17 September 2022.

4.D. Orders Preparation. All orders must be written utilizing PID RPT with BEA/BESA G3/MR. Students must have a current PHA/HIV. PHA is valid for (1) year and HIV is valid for (2) years from the date conducted. Due to the required gear list, one piece of excess baggage is authorized.

4.E. Required and optional student gear/equipment. Note, the CMCR staff does not have gear. Marines must arrive with all required gear.

4.E.1. Required gear:

- Face masks.
- Two set MCCU Woodland MARPAT utility uniform.
- Two pair combat boots.
- Gortex top and bottom.
- As needed warming layers (poly pro, green sweatshirt, etc).
- Pair gloves (unit issued).
- Two service pistol (M18) magazine pouches.
- Two service pistol (M18) magazines.
- Service pistol holster (M18 holster).
- Green cartridge or gear belt (Blackhawk, 511, etc).

- Two service rifle (M16/M4) magazine pouches.
- Six service rifle magazines.
- H-Harness or Load Bearing Vest (LBV).
- Camel Back.
- Body armor (Flak VST).
- Kevlar helmet with AN/PVS-14 NVG mount attached.
- Sleeping bag or system (linen will not be provided).
- Valid ID Card.
- Set ID Tags.
- Two sets of hearing protection or muffs.
- Eye protection/sunglasses.
- Sunscreen.
- Color highlighters, markers, pens, note taking material.
- Two combination locks.
- Personal hygiene items/towel/shower shoes.
- Laundry bag w/pin (required for laundry service).
- Vickers Common Weapons Sling, 2-Point.

4.E.2. Optional gear:

- First aid kit.
- Green/black/desert bag or pack (unit issued or personal).
- Binoculars large or small (unit issued or personal).
- Knee/elbow pads.

5. Command and Signal.

5.A. Reporting. Report to Course Director, Combat Marksmanship Coach Reserve (CMCR) Course, 26102 Bailey Avenue, Camp Upshur, MCB Quantico, VA, 22134, NLT 1800 on 17 September 2022. Proper civilian attire is authorized for check-in.

5.B. Delays. In case of unforeseen circumstances (e.g., flight delays/cancellations, weather, etc), contact the Schoolhouse prior to 1800 (17 September) in order to notify of the situation. The Schoolhouse phone number is (703) 784-2127. Due to the compressed time frame and intense period of instruction, Marines who arrive after 1200 on the convene date (18 September) will be returned to their parent command; students must plan to arrive by 1800 on 17 September 2022.

5.C. Cancellation. In the event a primary nominee cannot attend and to avoid the loss of school seats, notify appropriate MSC as soon as possible so alternates can be coordinated.
